BACKGROUND: Riverside County Department of Public Health Disease Control Branch is collaborating with Jurupa Unified School District on the ongoing project, Healthy Children's Connection, with the goal of promoting early entry into prenatal care and timely immunizations of children. Jurupa Unified School District offers services to clients in District 2 with funding through the First 5 Commission (formerly the Riverside County Commission on Family and Children) in the amount of \$95,712.

Although the Riverside County Department of Public Health is the lead Agency, collaborative partners are needed to ensure effective implementation of the program at a local level.
