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SUBJECT: Contract Agreement with University of Phoenix, for the Student Intern Field Experience Program

BACKGROUND:

On June 18, 1997, DPSS entered into their first contract with Loma Linda University/Hospital to facilitate student interns, from the University to obtain their clinical learning experience required in the University's curriculum. The Contract Agreement was effective as of April 23, 1997.

On September 15, 2002, DPSS Director signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with La Sierra University to provide a facility for student interns to receive field experience in social work education. This MOU is reviewed on an annual basis.

On September 9, 2003, (Agenda #3.58), the Board authorized DPSS to execute a contract with California State University, Long Beach for the Child Protective Services Student Intern Program. This Contract Agreement is through May 31, 2008.

And, on November 18, 2003, (Agenda #3.25), your Honorable Board authorized DPSS to enter into contracts with California State University, San Bernardino for the Student Intern Programs. DPSS agreed to provide clinical social work experience for Graduate and undergraduate Social Work students through the Child Protective Services and Adult Protective Services, Student Intern Programs. These Student Interns were thoroughly screened including LiveScan for background checks, drug testing, and physical examinations. Additionally, any legal documents produced by the Student Intern required supervisor approval.

These mutually beneficial programs provide the necessary avenue for students to gain needed field work experience, and gives DPSS the opportunity to introduce students to the public sector with the hope that when students gain their degree, they will be assimilated into the DPSS environment.

The University of Phoenix is a respected accredited university helping adults achieve their career goals. Their corporate headquarters is located in Phoenix, Arizona and they have over 195 campuses and learning centers throughout North America. This is a new relationship between DPSS and the University of Phoenix, in support of both Child and Adult Protective Services.

FINANCIAL DATA: No County General Funds will be required.
