SUBJECT: Employment Training Panel (ETP) Project

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Riverside County Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Accept \$294,040 in State of California ETP funding; and
- 2) Authorize the Workforce Development Administrator to execute Agreements with the State of California, University of California, Riverside (UCR), and additional sub contractors as needed.

BACKGROUND: ETP is an State of California employer-supported training program that trains new employees for high-wage, high-skill jobs and retrain employed workers in companies that face out-of-state competition. In 2004, EDA received ETP funding and partnered with UCR to retrain 150 existing employees of local manufacturers.

As a result of our success, EDA submitted a proposal to retrain 300 employees. At the December 15, 2006 ETP Panel Meeting, EDA was awarded \$294,040 for Program Years 2006-2009. EDA will be responsible for the overall administration of the agreement and will subcontract with UCR and other vendors to provide the retraining.
