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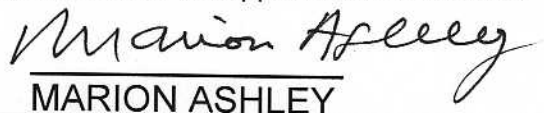
BACKGROUND:

The City of Moreno Valley which is the second largest city in Riverside County, represents 45% of the 5th district constituency. As the largest single constituency in the 5th district, it is incumbent on me to support and sponsor their major events which include the Mayor's Ball, the State of the City Luncheon, Taste of the Valley, and Citizen of the Year Dinner to name a few. \$10,000 allows me to support these events for the entire year of 2007.

The Western Riverside County Transportation NOW Perris/Moreno Valley Chapter meets monthly to determine ways to promote and expand transportation alternatives. As the Supervisor that represents both Moreno Valley and Perris, I encourage their mission and wish to sponsor the lunches for their meetings through the end of the fiscal year.

The Moreno Valley Unified School District has identified some cultural diversity issues at Moreno Valley High School which they are attempting to address through a two-day workshop. They have asked the Justice Department to mediate the workshop which will be conducted March 20 and 21 at the Moreno Valley Conference and Recreation Center. The cost of the Moreno Valley Conference and Recreation Center is \$2,000 which the 5th district is asking to cover to assist in the mediation.

The total cost of these three items is \$14,000 and I urge the Board to support these three uses of Community Improvement Funds for the 5th district.
