SUBJECT: Ordinance No. 889 An Ordinance Repealing Urgency Ordinance No. 888 Regulating Targeted Residential Picketing

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Board of Supervisors:

Introduce and adopt Ordinance No. 889, an ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 888, an urgency ordinance regulating targeted residential picketing.

BACKGROUND:

Ordinance No. 888 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on January 6, 2009, as an urgency ordinance effective immediately. The enforcement of Ordinance No. 888, however, was suspended pending the Board's adoption of Ordinance No. 884, which is separately agendized.

Since the enforcement of Ordinance No. 888 has been suspended and language is proposed to be added to Ordinance No. 884 which would reduce the area within which targeted residential picketing is prohibited from 50 to 30 feet from the property, it is recommended that urgency Ordinance No. 888 be repealed.
