BACKGROUND:

Summary

On March 12, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved the owner/architect agreement between the County of Riverside and Holt Architects, Inc. (Holt) for the East County Emergency Operations Center. The Economic Development Agency (EDA) had the intention of providing an audio and visual component to the project in Phase II, to assist Riverside County Fire Department's Office of Emergency Services in response to emergency situations. Holt has completed the plans and specifications for the audio and visual component for the ECEOC Phase II project.

On June 25, 2013, the Board of Supervisors approved a revised budget of \$11,131,201 for the East County Emergency Operations Center. Currently, there is approximately \$250,000 of uncommitted funds for the project. EDA anticipates the work for the audio and visual system will cost approximately \$600,000; therefore approval of a budget adjustment will be requested, if necessary, at the time of bid award.

The bid documents are now complete; therefore EDA requests approval to solicit bids for construction of this project. EDA will return to the Board under separate cover to approve the project budget and execute any project related agreements.

Impact on Residents and Businesses

The equipment when installed will assist Riverside County Fire Department's Office of Emergency Services in their response to natural disasters and other emergency situations. The proposed work for the audio and visual equipment installation will not impact residents or businesses as the work will be contained to project site.
